MOHAWK - a multi-functional day centre for children with special needs, in 5 acres of beautiful countryside just outside Wargrave. The centre provides a range of activities throughout the year, facilities and a natural space to encourage children with a variety of special needs to play, socialise and learn in a secure and caring environment.



CHILTERN CENTRE - promotes wider understanding of all aspects of brain injury and provides information, support and services to people with brain injury, their families and carers.
