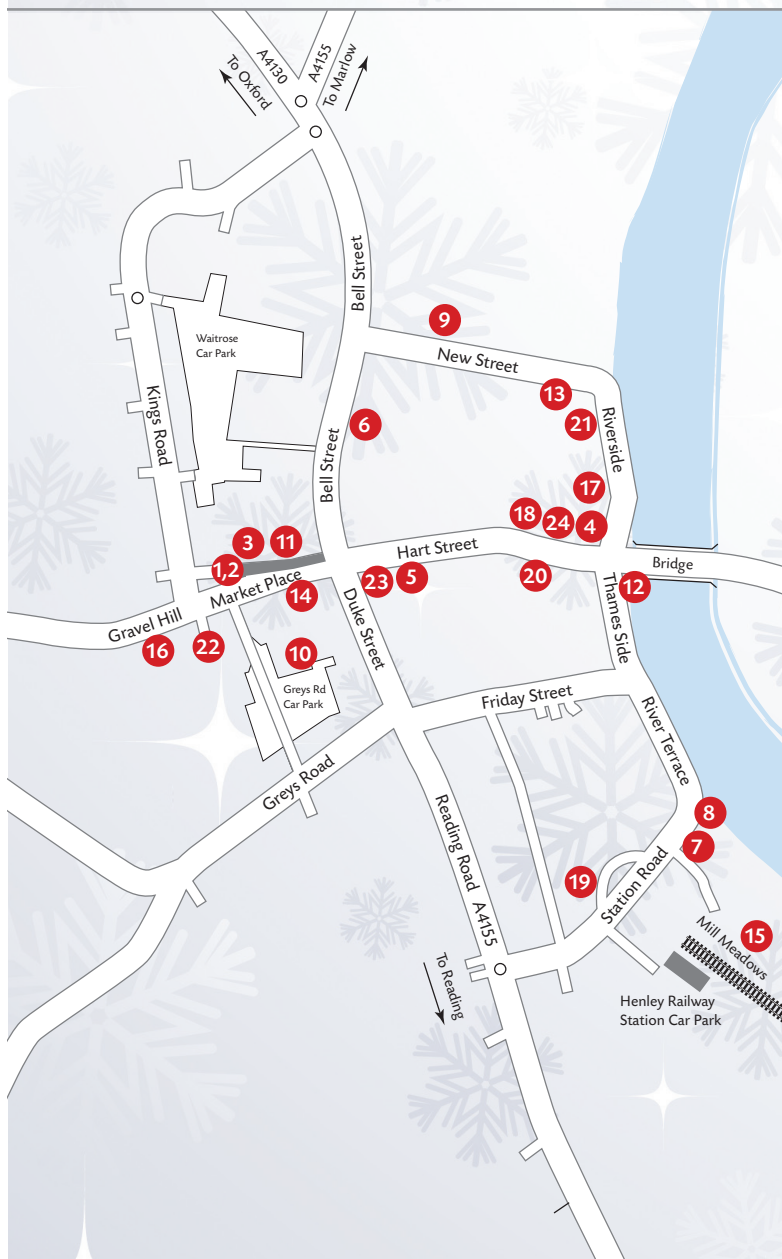




Henley Living Advent Calendar 2011
